

16 Hall Covered Bridge

Hall Bridge Road, Saxtons River, Vermont



Hall Covered Bridge was replaced in 1982 with a 120-foot design of traditional materials and timber framing methods, following its 1980 collapse due to the crossing of an overweight vehicle. While Hall Bridge was entered into the National Register of Historic Places on September 20, 1973, the National Register nomination form could not be found in Vermont State files.
